PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

Young professionals at the beginning of their careers have a high potential to change the world towards more sustainability. Since 2012, CLI has trained 100 young professionals in becoming **Young Leaders for Sustainability (YLS)**. CLI has organised YLS around the six dimensions of the © **Collective Leadership Compass**, two dimensions are covered in each compulsory training module. However, the holistic approach of the compass is always at the centre of the training and enables YLS participants to find suitable solutions to the complex problems of sustainability.

After finishing the three compulsory modules and two online sessions, the Young Leaders become part of a network of skilled specialists around the world who **scale collaboration and impact for sustainability**. CLI has taken into account the flexibility young leaders need to participate in such a programme in addition to their job or studies. So you can choose to start either with **module 1** or **module 2** and there are different date options, too. They take place in Potsdam, Germany. For international participants, there is also the opportunity to participate in these modules in one of our training centres in Cape Town (South Africa) Amman (Jordan), or Siem Reap (Cambodia). **Module 3** has one fixed date at the end of the year and is taking place in Potsdam. This is the time when YLS participants from all over the world gather to present their projects to the others, while strengthening their facilitation skills and building the YLS network at the same time.

MODULE 1: WHOLENESS & INNOVATION, 3-DAY TRAINING

This module is about exploring leadership together with experienced leaders in sustainable development and getting to know the Collective Leadership Compass. In this course you learn how to implement more outcome-oriented and constructive co-creation on a day-to-day basis for yourself, your team, your organization, and your change initiative with diverse stakeholders.

MODULE 2: ENGAGEMENT & COLLECTIVE INTELLIGENCE, 4-DAY TRAINING

In this module the topics of networking and getting your processes on track are the focus. The CLI methodology Dialogic Change Model is introduced to foster engagement and collective intelligence. You build your strategic abilities and implementation skills in stakeholder engagement, dialogue, and collaboration processes.

MODULE 3: FUTURE POSSIBILITIES & HUMANITY, 4-DAY TRAINING

The final module equips you with dialogic facilitation skills. It enhances your competency to build consensus and commitment for implementation and outcome-orientation. It helps you navigating the unpredictable, sometimes conflictual, dynamics of multi-stakeholder engagement processes.
