
WELCOME

Are you a professional involved in multi-stakeholder partnerships or complex collaboration projects?

Do you want to develop new engagement strategies to create sustainable partnerships and to minimise unproductive conflict? Do you need a powerful tool to create processes that foster solutions to complex sustainability challenges?

In this course, you will build your strategic abilities and implementation skills in stakeholder engagement, dialogue, and collaboration processes for high impact solutions. 
CLI's training programmes come to you

You are interested in one of our open course formats, but the dates or places do not meet your schedule?

You have a group of 16 or more people that needs to be trained locally? You prefer a local setting at the venue of your choice or want to safe travel expenses for your group?

We offer a 4-day on-site capacity building program based on the course of your choice of the CLI standard educational program. These courses include:

- The Art of Stakeholder Collaboration
- Advanced Stakeholder Collaboration*
- The Art of Dialogue
- The Art of Leading Collectively




We offer the courses in English, German, French, and Spanish. However, trainings in other languages with simultaneous interpreting can also be booked upon request.

For the on-site course, the programme will be designed with a focus on project or country-specific objectives, including a review and analysis of the project, preparatory interviews with participants, facilitation design and all

training material, implementation of the course with two facilitators, debriefing with an option of follow-on capacity building, and a debriefing report with recommendations, all in close communications with your core team.

Training your team on-site can reduce travel costs and makes your planning flexible. We offer this kind of training for 16+ participants and it becomes more affordable the more participants you have. Different projects or organisations can also jointly register to have an on-site training together. You can specify the location, dates, and number of participants (up to 24). Two of our expert trainers will be made available to implement your training.

For the next levels to come, the Compass Tool can also be used on team-, organisation-, and collaboration system level and includes features for a Collective Leadership community.





Accredited Collective Leadership Facilitators are fully empowered to facilitate CLI core courses and facilitate multi-stakeholder processes using Collective Leadership methodologies. Accredited CL Facilitators may lead their own not-for-profit courses in:



- The Art of Stakeholder Collaboration
- The Art of Leading Collectively

This entails that in addition to undergoing the Certified Collective Leadership Specialist programme, they must successfully organise and co-facilitate their own course supervised and supported by an experienced CLI facilitator. Furthermore, they publish a reflective or applied case study on CLI methodologies.




Throughout all phases of the accreditation process, trainees are responsible for demonstrating to CLI faculty fluency with the Collective Leadership approach, aptitude for facilitation and coaching, and a capacity for personal reflection and growth. In order to become accredited, trainees must also embody values such as inclusivity, respect for diversity, professionalism, and a commitment to contributing to the sustainability movement.



Becoming an accredited Collective Leadership Facilitator is also a compulsory qualification to become a **Collective Leadership Expert** (a person who cofacilitated several courses and practiced dialogic facilitation on a number of complex multi-stakeholder projects, more about this qualification in our next catalogue).
